Cuimhneamh an Chláir: Our Story

Cuimhneamh an Chláir / Clare Memories is an independent, voluntary charity, which digitally records, archives and shares the oral heritage of Co. Clare, through interviews with the county's older citizens in its diverse communities. To do this we train and mobilise volunteers known as 'Cuairteoirí', who visit people in their own communities to record their stories. This is in homage to the old tradition of 'going on cuaird'; a practice which centres on respectful listening to and conversation with the elders of a community.



Cuimhneamh an Chláir was founded in 2009 and is unique in being the only structured, collective, county-wide, community-based oral history gathering initiative in Ireland. In 13 years we have amassed an archive of thousands of hours of Clare oral history. We are leaders among community-owned oral history projects, having a strong focus on sharing the collected material with the communities who bequeathed it. This is done through community events and digitally via podcast and social media.

Our main working and funding partnership is with Clare County Council, with whom we currently have a Memorandum Of Understanding for the delivery of Folklore & Oral History Assistance to the Cultural Services division of Clare County Council. Our work and the importance of Co. Clare's oral cultural heritage is recognised in the Clare County Development Plan 2023 – 2029 (CDP16.18), and we are proud to be named in this document as partner in Clare County Council's expressed objective of preserving and promoting County Clare's oral heritage.

We have been nominated for numerous national and international awards for the unique nature of our work. We have co-founded the Oral History Network of Ireland. We have been approached to partner on Third Level research projects. We have successfully leveraged funding from Rethink Ireland, The Heritage Council and LEADER for projects to support our work.
